Voters pass millages, select finalists for November ballot

ROYAL OAK/CLAWSON — With the closing of the polls Aug. 7 in Royal Oak, Clawson and

throughout Oakland County, many decisions were made and even more ballots were set for the Nov. 6 general election.

Unofficial voter turnout was as expected by local city clerks, with

about 25.40 percent (12,356 voters) coming out the polls in Royal Oak, 25.41 percent (2,395 voters) in Clawson and 25.69 percent (236,211 voters) in the county.

"Things went extremely well in

Royal Oak," said Melanie Halas, Royal Oak city clerk. "I have excellent precinct workers, and I couldn't have such a smooth day without them. They are extremely dedicated,

CLASSIC CAR FANS FIND HAVEN IN WOODWARD WAREHOUSE

New facility offers club atmosphere alongside vehicle storage space



ROYAL OAK — Classic cars are commonplace in the city during the Woodward Dream Cruise, but a new local business is making Royal Oak a haven for the classic vehicles year round.

The Woodward Warehouse, 4260 Edgeland, just northeast of Normandy and Coolidge, can house up to 56 classic vehicles in its 14,000-square-foot facility, which just opened June 23 and has already earned plenty of attention.

"We're trying to create a car enthusiast environment," co-founder Joe Polito said. "We're not trying to sell just storage as a commodity; we're trying to sell a club-type environment. We're going to have various events here that are of interest to car enthusiasts."

Polito wants The Woodward Warehouse to not just be a storage facility, but a club for car enthusiasts where they can hang out. Several lounges and conference rooms are featured and include a pool table, two vintage Jokerz and Big Brave pinball machines, a cigar lounge, a large conference room, a full-service kitchen, a TV room and a patio with a barbecue. The facility features six

52- to 54-inch televisions, and plans for a storage locker room are under

"The concept was to go to a place for guys who like cars, and they can escape from their wives and lives and whatever," said co-founder Ron Pruette.

With the building sitting vacant for more than three years, Polito began toying with the idea while planning for his retirement as a lawyer. He has six classic cars of his own, but had been storing them at various relatives' houses, sometimes in damp garages in less-than-ideal conditions.

"It's just something I've been thinking about for quite a few years," Polito said. "I was looking at retirement and what I could do to keep active."

The warehouse club is the only one of its kind in Michigan, Polito said. They're common in coastal states, and there are a few in Ohio, all of which are pretty successful, and Polito hopes his can reach the local niche audience. He said interest has grown during the past three months, and the facility already houses about 17 vehicles, as well as two motorcycles and the actual 1952 Triumph See WAREHOUSE on page 20A
